UNITED METHODIST CITY SOCIETY APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

For the academic year 2012-2013

Requirements and Procedures

- I. The applicant must be a member of a United Methodist Church in the New York Annual Conference.
- II. The Scholarship Fund is designated **primarily** to assist those persons who are planning to enter full-time ordained ministry in a United Methodist Church with special interest in urban ministry.
- III. The scholarship shall be granted primarily to a person studying in a program at a college, university or seminary approved by the Scholarship Committee of the United Methodist City Society. Other priorities listed in IX.
- IV. Applicant must present to the Scholarship Committee a current transcript of scholastic standing in the school where applicant has been studying, a diploma, and/or a copy of letter of acceptance in the college/seminary where the applicant will be studying. A transcript from a previous school or previous year in a school is required.
- V. Applications are received through the office of the United Methodist City Society. 475 Riverside Drive, Room 1922, New York, NY 10115. Attn: Rev. Dr. William S. Shillady.
- VI. The scholarship granted shall be paid to the educational institution involved. It shall be the responsibility of the recipient to send the following to the United Methodist City Society office:
 - 1. The applicant's proof that he/she is fully registered in the college or seminary.
 - 2. The applicant's course list.
 - 3. The business office bill for tuition.

The UMCS will send the scholarship check made payable to the institution. It will be sent to the recipient to give to the institution's business office. Grants will vary depending upon full time and part time programs. Scholarship amounts vary upon the number of applicants and their degree level.

VII. If a student leaves the school after being granted a scholarship, the school shall return any remaining balance to the United Methodist City Society.

- Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. Applicant must apply separately VIII. each year. Financial need will be taken into consideration. Please complete the financial information part of the application and provide a copy of your (or your parents) Federal 1040 form. (The first two summary pages of the 1040)
- IX. Scholarship monies will be used in the following areas:
 - a. Undergraduate degree program
 - Graduate --. Master of Divinity. b.
 - Those who need special expertise or training in urban ministry. c
- X. The funds would not be used for those who are doing additional graduate work or continuing education. A Doctoral degree program is not funded.
- XI. The deadline for scholarship application is Tuesday, May 8th, 2012 at 12 NOON. The application must be in our office or on email by the deadline. FAX: 212-870-3091 E-Mail: bshillady@umcitysociety.org Or hand delivered by noon at room 1922 at 475 Riverside Drive, NY New York 10115.

Awards will be announced at the Annual Conference Session for the school year 2012-2013.

There is the need for reference letters sent by your pastor, your candidacy mentor and by your District Superintendent. These letters should be sent by them independently and directly to the City Society Office. You should do all within reason to have them respond to us by May 8th, 2012. However, your application will not be denied if we have not received the letters of reference by that date. We will work with you to have them submit these letters before the meeting of the committee.
