



URBAN MINISTRY SCHOLARSHIP FUND 2021-2022

Dear Friends in Christ,

A copy of the application for the 2021 - 2022 Urban Ministry Scholarship of the United Methodist City Society is enclosed and is also available at the City Society website, www.umcitysociety.org.

Funds are available for those persons who have demonstrated experience and interest in urban ministry, along with some level of financial need. The Scholarship Fund is designated **primarily** to assist those persons who are planning to enter full-time ordained ministry in the United Methodist Church with special interest in urban ministry.

All candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Membership in a church in the New York Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church;
- Enrollment in a seminary approved by the University Senate of the United Methodist Church;
- Will be a full or part time seminary student for the academic year 2021-2022.
- Must be a certified a candidate, or an inquiring candidate, with an assigned mentor, in the candidacy process of the New York Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church;
- Provide proof of financial need.

Priority in the awards will be given to persons who have a desire to enter full time ordained ministry in the United Methodist Church in an urban setting.

The Scholarship Committee will **NOT** review applications from persons that:

- Are not members of churches in the New York Annual Conference;
- Are not involved in urban ministries currently;
- Are pursuing additional advanced degrees (i.e. second master's degree or doctoral degree); and
- Are not pursuing programs that will lead to a degree.
- Are NOT attending an approved seminary.

The application for the UMCS Urban Ministry Scholarship is due by May 7th, 2021. All applications received by this deadline will be considered for a full year scholarship. The scholarship award will be for both the fall and spring semesters.

To assist as many students as possible the City Society will now offer a limited number of "rolling scholarships", if funds remain available, through December 31st, 2021. These scholarships are available to candidates unable to meet the May deadline. Applications received after May will be considered for the upcoming semester (one semester only), depending on the submission date. The City Society is not able to award an additional scholarship to candidates who received an award in June.

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UNITED METHODIST CITY SOCIETY APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

For the academic year 2021 - 2022

Requirements and Procedures

- I. The applicant must be a member of a United Methodist Church in the New York Annual Conference.
- II. The Scholarship Fund is designated to assist those persons who are planning to enter full-time ordained ministry in a United Methodist Church with special interest in urban ministry. Scholarship Candidates should be pursuing candidacy in the New York Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church or explain why they are not in the candidacy for ministry track.
- III. The scholarship shall be granted to a person studying in a seminary approved by the University Senate of the United Methodist Church. Unfortunately, at this time New York Theological Seminary is not approved.
- IV. Applicant must present to the Scholarship Committee a current official transcript of scholastic standing of the seminary in which they are enrolled. If attending college and are graduating and entering seminary, then a copy of the college transcript, and/or a copy of the letter of acceptance in the seminary where the applicant will be studying. A transcript from a previous school or previous year in a school is required.
- V. Letters of recommendation are required from your <u>pastor</u>, <u>candidacy mentor</u> (if you are in the process for United Methodist ordained ministry or are already certified) and <u>District Superintendent</u>. All recommendation letters should be addressed to Rev. Dr. William S. Shillady and must be emailed separately and directly by recommenders to:

Please encourage your recommender to meet the May 7th, 2021 deadlines. If you are having trouble securing a letter of recommendation in advance of the deadline, please contact the City Society for assistance in following up with your Pastor, Mentor and DS. Your application **will not be denied** if we have not received your reference letters by May 7th.

- VI. Applications are received through the office of the United Methodist City Society. Email applications to scholarshipinfo@umcitysociety.org, or mail them directly to 475 Riverside Drive, Room 1922, New York, NY 10115. Attn: Urban Ministry Scholarship Committee
- VII. The scholarship granted shall be paid to the educational institution involved. Scholarships are given at different funding levels to part-time and full-time students. It shall be the responsibility of the recipients of the scholarship to send the following to the United Methodist City Society office for their first and second semester:
 - a. The applicant's proof that he/she is fully registered in the seminary.
 - b. The applicant's course list showing full time or part time status:
 - 1. Part Time students are given payment toward academic courses only.
 - 2. Field Education is not paid for by scholarship funding.
 - c. A copy of the tuition bill.

- VIII. The UMCS will send the scholarship check made payable to the institution. It will be sent to the recipient to give to the institution's business office. Scholarship amounts vary upon the number of applicants, financial need, funding levels, and excellence for ministry.
 - IX. If a student leaves the school after being granted a scholarship, the school shall return any remaining balance to the United Methodist City Society.
 - X. Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. **Applicants must apply separately each academic year.** Applications received after the May 7th deadline will be eligible for one semester only. Financial need will be taken into consideration. Please complete the financial information part of the application and provide a copy of your Federal 1040 form. (The first two summary pages of the 1040.) Additional financial information may be requested by the committee.
 - XI. Scholarship monies will be used for a Master of Divinity degree or for those who need special expertise or training in urban ministry.
- XII. The funds are not available for those who are doing additional graduate work or continuing education. Doctoral degree programs are not eligible for funding.
- XIII. The deadline for an annual scholarship (both semesters) is **Friday, May 7th, 2021.**The application must be emailed or postmarked (if sending via mail) by the deadline.

 Awards will be announced at the Annual Conference Session.

Rolling scholarships will be available through December 31st, 2021. Applications will be reviewed and processed by the committee as they are received. These scholarships are available to candidates who were unable to meet the May 7th, 2021 deadline. These will be grants for one semester, depending on time of application. The City Society is not able to award a "rolling scholarship" to candidates who received an award in June.

- Recommendations must be requested from your Pastor, DS, and Candidacy Mentor and must be sent independently from your application and received directly from your recommenders.
- Please complete the attached financial statement and attach the required first two pages of your 2020 tax forms.
